

FOOD & BEVERAGE HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

- i) All food and beverage must be handled in accordance with the Peel Health Department's Regulations and Standards. Please visit <http://www.peelregion.ca/health/environ/htmlfiles/events-intro.htm> for more information.
- ii) Cooking on-site is not permitted. Food may be only warmed up using equipment that is accepted by T.I.C.C. Acceptable cooking equipment includes: Electric devises and butane burners.
- iii) No propane, barbeques, deep fryers, oil grills, or flat tops are allowed on-site.
- iv) Any cooking equipment which may produce grease-laden vapours are not permitted.
- v) All butane burners must be placed on a back table away from the general public's reach.
- vi) All table cloths must be fire retardant.
- vii) Each vendor booth must have a fire extinguisher and a proper hand washing station.
